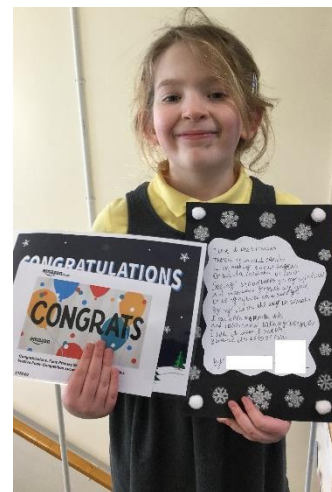
Reminders
